Creating a New Project

- On the Home Screen—tap New Project



- Select Blank Project

Editing a Project

Use the Tools on the Left to Create Visuals – you can create visuals before your record or while you are recording.

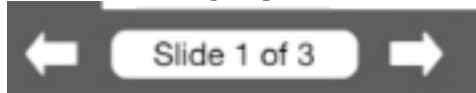
	New Slide—Add a new slide after the current slide
	Slide Sorter—View thumbnails of slides. Press & hold thumbnails to rearrange slide order
	Draw Tool—Pen tool to draw. Press & hold to change style.
	Laser Pointer—Press your finger to activate laser pointer.
	Shape Tool—Add shapes. Press & hold to change style.
	Text Tool—Insert text. Press & hold to change style
	Insert Image—Insert image from photo roll, camera, dropbox. Crop before inserting image.
	Delete/Erase—Tap delete and then select object you wish to delete and press the red X. This tool becomes an eraser when you are drawing.
	Arrange—Tap Arrange and the select the object you wish to arrange & move forward/backwards
	Undo—Undo last action (doesn't work during recording)
	Zoom & Pan—Zoom in and out using two-finger pinch. Use one finger to move around stage. Double tap to return to 100%.

Tip: To save an image in Safari, tap and hold image. Select Save Image.

Tip: To edit a shape or text, double tap on it.

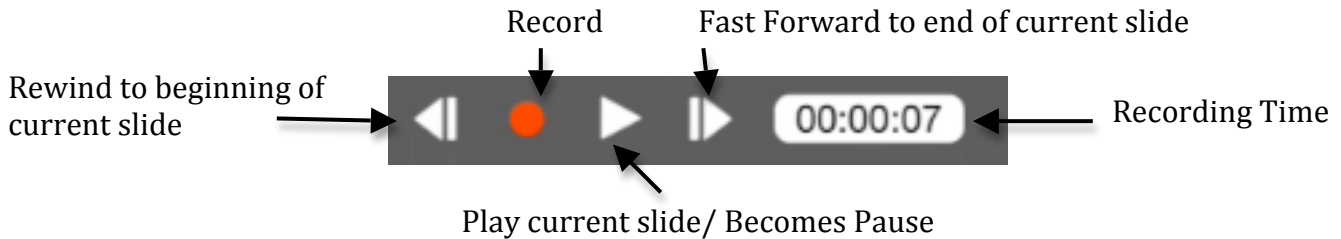
Navigating

To move between slides while recording, tap the forward or back arrows.



Recording

When recording, all the actions on the screen including drawing, moving, scaling, rotating, and addition of objects are recorded along with any audio.



Note: Each slide is recorded separately in the project. When the project is saved as a final movie, all the recorded slides will merge as one seamless movie.

Tip: To play the entire project at once, tap and hold the play button. Then tap on the yellow arrow.



Saving & Exporting

Explain Everything autosaves all projects any time that you leave the app.

- To save different versions or rename the project, Tap save.



- To share a project, tap Export Video/Project.
 - Select Movies to export final project to email or dropbox.
 - Select Projects to export file that you can continue to work on
